

Bicycle riders and helmets

- 1. It is a legal requirement for bicycle riders to wear helmets when riding on the road to and from school.
- 2. Students who ride bicycles to school must wear helmets to and from school.
- 3. The guidelines for bicycle riders are:
 - (i) Students who ride bicycles to school by Law are to wear helmets.
 - (ii) Students will be randomly checked for possession of their helmets.
 - (iii) If a student with a bicycle cannot produce his helmet, then after a warning from a supervising teacher, the student will be refused permission to ride his bicycle home.
 Caregivers will be contacted. The bicycle will be impounded at school for one night and secured at school unless collected by a caregiver.
 - (iv) The bicycle will be released when the owner produces his / her helmet the following day.
- 4. Students who ride bicycles will be aware of the conditions required by law and by the school for them to continue to ride safely to and from school.
