This funding will be used to

- Improve/progression towards the percentage of students at or above NMS for reading to 90%.
- Increase/progression towards the percentage of Year 7- 9 students achieving a C or above in English to 80%.
- Increase the proficiency of readers by implementing multi-tiered reading intervention.
- Increase the proficiency of teachers to differentiate learning for diverse learners.
- Improve attendance data at >85% present juncture from 73% - to 80%.
- Continue the achievement of 100% QCE for exiting Year 12 cohort.

Our initiatives include

- Continuing the roll out of existing reading intervention at decoding level.
- Implementing reading intervention, targeted directly at fluency and comprehension, including building staff capacity with high impact reading strategies.
- Implementing PAT R testing to inform planning and instruction.
- Building teacher capacity with "Knowing your Learner" and differentiating instruction to meet individual learner needs.
- Implementing a school wide observation, coaching and feedback program to enable all staff to improve teaching practice and differentiate instruction.
- Building staff capacity with wider data analysis to inform improved processes and practices.
- Continuing existing work with respect to attendance and business liaison.
- Continuing existing work with Engage2Learn Wellbeing Project – UQ Research Partnership.

Implementing targeted reading intervention, including program requirements, materials and teacher aide resourcing.	\$214 000
Continuing PAT R testing and data analysis (resources and staffing).	\$ 5 000
Implementing a targeted school wide observation, feedback and coaching program for all teaching staff to improve teaching and differentiate instruction.	\$ 36 375
Implementing staged roll out of teacher training - high yield strategies from Tactical Teaching Reading.	\$ 15 000
Employing additional Teacher Aide time to work with EALD students.	\$ 56 000
Continuing employment of the Attendance Office.	\$ 69 000
Continuing employment of the Business Liaison Officer.	\$ 69 000
Continuing Engage2Learn - Ongoing Project Fees (2015-2017).	\$ 10 000
Continuing to support school funded positions in teaching and learning and behaviour.	\$ 51 000



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
