BYOxLink - How to guide

Use guest Wi-Fi service to connect students' Windows devices

This document explains how a student can connect a Windows device to the school guest Wi-Fi network (EQGUEST) so staff can then complete the Intune enrolment on their device.

The guest Wi-Fi connection is limited and only lasts for eight hours. You may not be able to access some resources such as shared network drives, printers or local school websites through the guest Wi-Fi.

Note: Sign on will only work with a valid school email address i.e. username>@eq.edu.au. You should use your existing school EQ email address.

Step 1. Select the Guest Wi-Fi network

- a. Select the *W*i-Fi icon at the bottom right of the screen.
- b. Scroll the Wi-Fi networks to select EQGUEST. Select Connect.







Step 2. Sign on to the Guest Wi-Fi network

- a. A Sign on page will be displayed
- b. Enter your EQ email address and password



e. A success screen will display, close the window.
