Our initiatives include

- Establishing a school wide approach to reading, inclusive of TTR high yield strategies
- Building teacher capacity to implement differentiated weekly reading intervention for all year 7 students
- Refining and prioritise school processes relating to attendance, case management and intervention programs
- Undertaking intensive interventions for students in year 8 and 9 to focus on school re-engagement

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Providing resources and professional development for staff delivering targeted reading and literacy instruction in junior secondary.
- Employing additional teacher aides to support reading instruction in junior secondary.
- Employing Head of Year positions and an attendance officer to support student engagement, attendance and case management processes.
- Employing Business Liason Officer to support QCE attainment in senior school.
- Partnering with ICYS to provide Youth Support services to our students to improve engagement.
