**RESPONSIBILITY** to be ready to learn, ensuring your own safety and preparedness.

Students **MUST** wear full formal uniform at the following times:

- ✧ Formal Wednesday;
- ✧ Parades for special events, public events, and awards ceremonies;
- ✧ Mixing and matching of formal and sports uniforms is not acceptable;
- ✧ Excursions or activities where students represent the College. The exception to this is sporting events.

Students have a responsibility to:

- ✧ be in full school uniform every day;
- ✧ provide a note from your parent/caregiver on the unavoidable occasion that you are out of uniform;
- ✧ visit the Uniform Exchange from 8:00am to 8:45am in the Lower Administration Office to borrow a replacement uniform item for the day
- ✧ carry a pass with them, providing it to members of staff when asked.

If a student does not have an Out of Uniform Pass then the student must attend uniform exchange room.

# Uniform Policy

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✧ BSSC black and white striped blouse</li> <li>✧ BSSC mint green button up collared shirt</li> <li>✧ Tie is optional for boys and girls but must be worn at formal school events</li> <li>✧ Tie is compulsory for all year 11 and 12 students for the duration of terms 2 and 3</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✧ Black BSSC skirt – four inverted box pleats – 2 front 2 back (below knee length)</li> <li>✧ Flesh and plain coloured black stockings are optional with the shorts or skirt bottoms.</li> <li>✧ Black BSSC culottes</li> <li>✧ Black full length (to ankles) long tailored trousers (no jeans/leggings/tights/jeggings)</li> <li>✧ Black BSSC formal shorts</li> <li>✧ Belt is optional and must be plain black vinyl or leather if worn with plain belt buckle</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✧ BSSC unisex mint and black sports shirt/polo</li> <li>✧ BSSC unisex black sports shorts</li> <li>✧ BSSC tracksuit jacket</li> <li>✧ BSSC Tracksuit pants</li> </ul>

## All Uniforms

- ✧ Cap/hat – a sun safe cap or hat worn correctly with no offensive logos or wording (no beanies or hats without brims)
- ✧ BSSC bucket hat is optional
- ✧ No visible undershirts to be worn
- ✧ Hijab and religious clothing must be in school colours
- ✧ BSSC black school vest
- ✧ BSSC black blazer worn with the formal uniform
- ✧ BSSC black v neck polyester cotton jumper
- ✧ BSSC black scarves
- ✧ Visible plain white socks Please note
- ✧ All uniforms are to have BSSC College Logo on them
- ✧ Senior uniform items are conditional for senior students, and may be worn once they become available

Please note - Tracksuit pants can be worn with sports and formal uniform, but FORMAL shorts/skirt/trousers must be worn on formal occasions e.g. award assemblies



Shoes and Socks	Additional Items
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✧ Plain black impervious shoes (leather or vinyl) must be worn – canvas, ballet, high tops or shoes that are above the ankle and/or multi coloured shoes are not acceptable</li> <li>✧ Black laces or Velcro only</li> <li>✧ Visible plain white socks – plain black socks may be worn under full length long tailored trousers only</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✧ Only foundation is acceptable and must be minimal and natural colour</li> <li>✧ Students are encouraged to make use of colourless sun protection products</li> <li>✧ Nail polish is permitted - no other accessories or additions to fingernails are to be worn</li> <li>✧ Fake nails must be shaped to flat or rounded tips</li> <li>✧ Hair must not be dyed in colours that do not occur naturally</li> <li>✧ No extreme hairstyles</li> <li>✧ Hair ties and clips are recommended to be of natural hair colour or College colours</li> <li>✧ Hair should be kept clean, neat and tidy and out of eyes</li> <li>✧ Eyelashes should be of natural colours (any permanent eyelash extensions should be of natural colours if worn)</li> <li>✧ School badges &amp; school awarded excellence badges are permitted</li> <li>✧ A watch worn on the wrist</li> <li>✧ Earrings permitted to be worn are studs or sleepers. Studs in ears are not to have a head larger than 14mm in diameter</li> <li>✧ Sleepers in ears are small hoops and are not to be larger than 14mm in diameter</li> <li>✧ No plugs, stretchers, bars, extenders or hoops larger than 14mm diameter are permitted to be worn as earrings</li> <li>✧ A maximum of 2 facial piercings can be worn. Studs are the only items to be worn as facial piercings. Facial piercing studs are not to have a head larger than 6mm in diameter</li> <li>✧ Other necklaces, bracelets, anklets and rings must not be visible</li> <li>✧ Medic alert bracelets and necklaces can be worn where necessary</li> </ul>

**In reference to the word ‘tailored’ trousers or shorts. Tailored means a garment with:**

- ✧ Zip fly front
- ✧ Loopholes for a belt
- ✧ May have pockets at top of pants near waistband/hip region

**A tailored garment does not have:**

- ✧ Pockets mid-thigh

**A tailored garment in our uniform does not include:**

- ✧ Trackpants
- ✧ Denim jeans/pants or leggings
